



Stockpile (2015)

2-5 Players

Designer: Brett Sobol, Seth Van Orden

Duration: 5-7 rounds, depending on # of players. 45 minutes.



Board Setup

- Select a board side. For the Advanced board, each stock follows a different value track.
- Place the **Turn Marker**  on the calendar space for the # of players
- Place a **Stock Ticker**  on the starting values of each stock, indicated by darkened circles
- Shuffle and stack **Company Cards**  and **Forecast Cards**  next to the board in separate piles
- Pull out 1 each of the 6 different **stock cards**  from **Market Deck**  and deal 1 to each player, who places it face-down on **Stock Portfolio** spot of player board. Shuffle rest back into deck.

Player Setup

- Each player gets a **Bidding Meeple** , **Player Board** , and **\$20k** (3 x \$5k and 5 x \$1k)
- [optional] Deal each player 2 **Investor Cards** , pick 1, return the other to box
- Pick start player and give them **First Player Token** 

Expansions

- **Advanced Board**: if a stock goes bankrupt, return to starting position. If splits, return to octagon. Stanford Steel pays based on \$ on stock value track – as it passes or lands on \$ spaces as part of a **positive** value change, players get \$1k per \$ for each stock in possession.
- **Investors**: deal 2 cards to each player, pick 1 & return other to box. Determines starting \$. Abilities used during Action phase can be performed before or after playing Action cards

End Game & Scoring

- The game ends after the final **Movement Phase**. Any leftover Market Deck cards will not be used.
- Reveal # shares for each stock and determine **majority shareholder** [Split Portfolios count double]. **\$10k** for **majority shareholder** of each company. Tie: all tied players receive \$5k.
- Sell back shares at final value [Split Portfolios count double]
- Most \$ wins. Tie: no tiebreaker

Stockpile (2015)

Game Play

A round is played in **6 phases**:

- **Information:** deal 1 Company card & 1 Forecast card to each player (keep hidden). Put 1 Company card & 1 Forecast card face-up on the board, remaining pairs in piles next to board face-down.
- **Supply:** # of Stockpiles = # of players. Flip 1 card from Market deck face-up onto each Stockpile. Deal 2 cards from Market deck to each player. In turn order, place both cards in any Stockpile(s), 1 face-up, 1 face-down [player choice].
- **Demand:** In turn order, place Bidding Meeple on an open # of any Bidding Track. If outbid, re-bid on next turn. Cannot bid more than you have, max bid \$25k. Once no re-bids, players pay bank and pick up Stockpiles. Pay and discard any Trading Fee cards – if player does not have enough \$, hold card & pay immediately upon receiving enough \$. Put stocks in Portfolio, keep hidden.
- **Action:** in turn order, players use all their Action cards & place face-up in discard pile. *Boom!* – player moves 1 stock value up 2. *Bust!* – player moves 1 stock value down 2. If reaches **Split** or **Bankruptcy** space, follow rule below.
- **Selling:** in turn order, players may sell stock placing face-up in discard pile. Collect \$ equal to value. Stocks sold from Split portfolio pay 2x value or move stock back to regular portfolio and get 1x value.
- **Movement:** in turn order, reveal Company cards and Forecast cards & move values ending with face-up and face-down Company/Action pairs. \$\$ = pay dividends \$2,000 per share, split stocks pay 2x dividends. Must reveal share to get dividends (optionally do not reveal and do not collect dividends).
- **Splits:** if a stock's value exceeds 10, it splits. Reveal shares & move to Split portfolio face-down. Reset value to 6 and continue adding from there if more movement. New stock obtained after split goes in regular portfolio, not Split. If a stock splits again, player gets \$10k for each share already in Split portfolio [leave split stock in place].
- **Bankruptcy:** if stock's value goes < 1, it is bankrupt, players discard all stock of that type, set price = 5
- At round end, move Turn Marker to right, pass 1st Player token left, start another round
